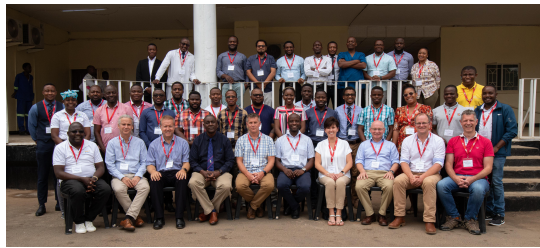


BOFAS Principles of Foot & Ankle Surgery - Huye University Campus, Rwanda
